

ORDINANCE NO. 2.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE VILLAGE OF FAIRMONT CITY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING ON THE 30TH DAY OF APRIL, A. D. 1915.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FAIRMONT CITY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1.

That there be and is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending on the 30th day of April, A. D. 1915, the sum of Five Hundred and One Hundred Dollars, to defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the said Village of Fairmont City, Illinois, accruing during said year, to be applied to the following objects and purposes, to-wit:

Elections-----	\$150.00
Printing and Stationery-----	100.00
Streets And Alleys -----	1000.00
Bridges And Culverts -----	200.00
Sidewalks,-----	500.00
Salaries -----	2450.00
Contingent and Necessary Expense-----	700.00
TOTAL -----	<u>5100.00</u>

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage, approval and due publication.
